Match Fee: \$20 per match if registered by noon on Friday prior to the match. Active duty military \$10 per match and junior competitors are free. Late registration is at the discretion of the match director, \$30.

Sign in at the range: Registration is by Practiscore; see below. Range will be open by 7:00am. Sign in will be at the trailer on the 600yd firing line between 7:15am and 8:15am. Sign in **will cease promptly at 8:15am.** **Please be at the range and signed in by 8:15am.** Late arrivals may be turned away at the discretion of the Match Director.

Eligibility: Open to the public. Anyone who can legally possess a firearm, or juniors accompanied by a parent or guardian may compete. The Match Director or Chief Range Officer reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition, or competitor.

Equipment Allowed: In accordance with current NRA rules. F-Class Rifles allowed are: (3.4.a) F-Class Open Rifle, (3.4.b) F-Class Target Rifle. **Compensators, suppressors and muzzle brakes are prohibited** (3.16.1). **Empty chamber indicators are required** (3.21).

Course of Fire: F-Class Prone Course (Rule 7.20)

Match 1 Unlimited sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target.
Match 2 2 sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target.
Match 3 2 sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target.
Match 4 The Aggregate of Matches 1 through 3.

Competitors are required to perform scoring and pit duty (unless electronic targets are in use) on their assigned relay and target set up after sign-in and re-facing at match conclusion. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Classifications: NRA High Power classifications will be established and updated at the end of the league. Match results will be printed and given to each competitor following the match and posted on the website as soon as possible. Nebraskafclass.com

Awards: Individual awards for a single match will be for bragging rights only. Medals for top three shooters in F-O and F-TR will be awarded after the completion of the aggregate match. Medals will be awarded to top shooter in marksman, sharpshooter, and expert class if at least three shooters in class.

General Information: Squadding will be finalized at the range on the day of the match. Range capacity with electronic (Shot Marker) targets is 40 shooters. Twenty-five minute block includes three minute preparation period. Registration is by Practiscore. Registration closes at noon on the Friday before the match. There is no state championship match this year. Check nebraskafclass.com and schedule on ENG C website engc.us/home for updates.

Portable toilets are available. No food or water is provided. Bring what you need. Breaks for meals and or refreshments will not be given.
