<u>Match Fee:</u> \$20 per match if registered by noon on Friday prior to the match. Late registration is at the discretion of the match director, \$30.

<u>Sign in at the range:</u> Registration and payment is by Practiscore; see below. Range will be open by 7:00am. Sign in will be on the 600 yard firing line between 7:15am and 8:15am. Sign in will cease promptly at 8:15am. Please be at the range and signed in by 8:15am. The match may begin early if all registrants are present. Late arrivals may be turned away at the discretion of the Match Director.

<u>Eligibility:</u> Open to the public. Anyone who can legally possess a firearm, or juniors accompanied by a parent or guardian may compete. The Match Director or Chief Range Officer reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition, or competitor.

**Equipment :** In accordance with current NRA rules. F-Class Rifles allowed are: (3.4.a) F-Class Open Rifle, (3.4.b) F-Class Target Rifle. **Compensators, suppressors and muzzle brakes are prohibited** (3.16.1). **Empty chamber indicators are required** (3.21). Electronic targets are in use. You must bring a web browsing device that you are familiar with.

## Course of Fire: F-Class Prone Course (Rule 7.16)

- Match 1 Unlimited sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target.
- Match 2 2 sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target. 2 sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target. 2 sighter shots, 20 shots for record, 25 minute block time at 600 yds. MR-1F target.
- **Match 4** The Aggregate of Matches 1 through 3.

<u>Classifications:</u> NRA High Power classifications will be established and updated at the end of the league. Match results will be available at the end of the match, and posted on the website as soon as possible. Nebraskafclass.com

<u>Awards:</u> Individual awards for a single match will be for bragging rights only. Medals for top three shooters in F-O and F-TR will be awarded after the completion of the aggregate match. Medals will be awarded to top shooter in marksman, sharpshooter, and expert class if at least three shooters in class.

<u>General Information:</u> Squadding will be finalized at the range on the day of the match. Range capacity with electronic (Shot Marker) targets is 40 shooters. Twenty-five minute block includes three minute preparation period. Registration and payment is by Practiscore. Registration closes at noon on the Friday before the match. Sling shooters are welcome at F Class matches, but there are no awards for this discipline. At this time, there is no state championship match scheduled for 2023.
